Summary

- During the month of January Gujarat has pressed 15,09,754 Running Bales of Shankar 6 and 52,800 Running Bales of V-797, Total 15,62,554 Running Bales. So the statistical bales of 170 Kgs. was 14,38,707 Bales of Shankar 6, 50,315 Bales of V-797 and total 14,89,022 Bales.
- Cumulative Pressing till 31thJanuary is 51,20,274 Bales (Shankar 6 50,63,274 Bales and V-797 57,000 Bales), which is equivalent to total 48,79,320 Bales of 170 Kgs. (Shankar 6 48,25,002 Bales and V-797 54,318 Bales).
- Average per day Pressing was 50,405 Running Bales and 48,033 Bales 170 Kgs. for 31 days.
- During the month of January Total active ginning factories were 656 (Saurashtra 400,
 North Gujarat 204, Main Line 34 and Kutch 18).

Daily pressing average was 50,405 running bales per day. Per factory per day pressing average is 76.84 bales a day which indicates that due to disparity ginning are running very slow.

Still farmers are not willing to sale at lower rate and this slow arrival will be maintained for long period of time and season will run long despite low cotton production.
