


MONTHLY PRESSING REPORT AUG-2019

MONTHLY PRESSING REPORT AUG-2019

Summary

- During the month of August Gujarat has pressed 70,090 Running Bales of Shankar
 6 and there was no pressing of V-797. So, the statistical bales of 170 Kg. was
 66,792 Bales (Shankar 6).
- Cumulative Pressing in running bales till 31st August is 94,63,072 Bales (Shankar 6 92,42,736 Bales and V-797 2,20,336 Bales), which is equivalent to total 90,17,751 Bales of 170 Kgs. (Shankar 88,07,784 Bales and V-797 2,09,967 Bales).
- One new ginning unit from Una was added this month with full year pressing.
- Average per day Pressing was 2,261 Running Bales and 2,155 Bales 170 Kg. for 31 days.
- During the month of August Total active ginning factories were 33 (Saurashtra 33, North Gujarat NIL, Main Line NIL and Kutch NIL).

Most of the ginning factories are closed now, only few in Saurashtra are open during monsoon season. Still good quantities of kapas with Saurashtra farmers, how many bales would be pressed from this kapas stock will depend on weather and market situation.


Gujarat ginners have off loaded good quantity of stock cotton during this month but still are holding old cotton stock. Now ginners are in selling mood and so the market remains under selling pressure. As of now there are around 33 ginning factories in Saurashtra which are still operational and most of them will continue their operation throughout the monsoon season with slow pace.
