Summary

- During the month of May Gujarat has pressed 2,44,044 Bales (S-6 2,33,024 Bales, V-797 11,020 Bales), which is equivalent to total 2,32,560 Bales of 170 Kgs. (Shankar 2,22,058 Bales, V-797 10,501 Bales).
- Cumulative Pressing in running bales till 31st May is 91,01,396 Running Bales of Shankar 6 and 1,66,570 Running bales of V-797, Total Pressing 92,67,966 Bales. So, the statistical bales of 170 Kg. is 86,73,095 Bales of Shankar 6 and 1,58,731 Bales of V-797.
- Average pressing per day was 7,872 Running Bales and 7,502 Bales 170 Kg. for 31 days.
- During the month of May Total active ginning factories were 147 (Saurashtra 118, North Gujarat 25, Main Line 3 and Kutch 1).

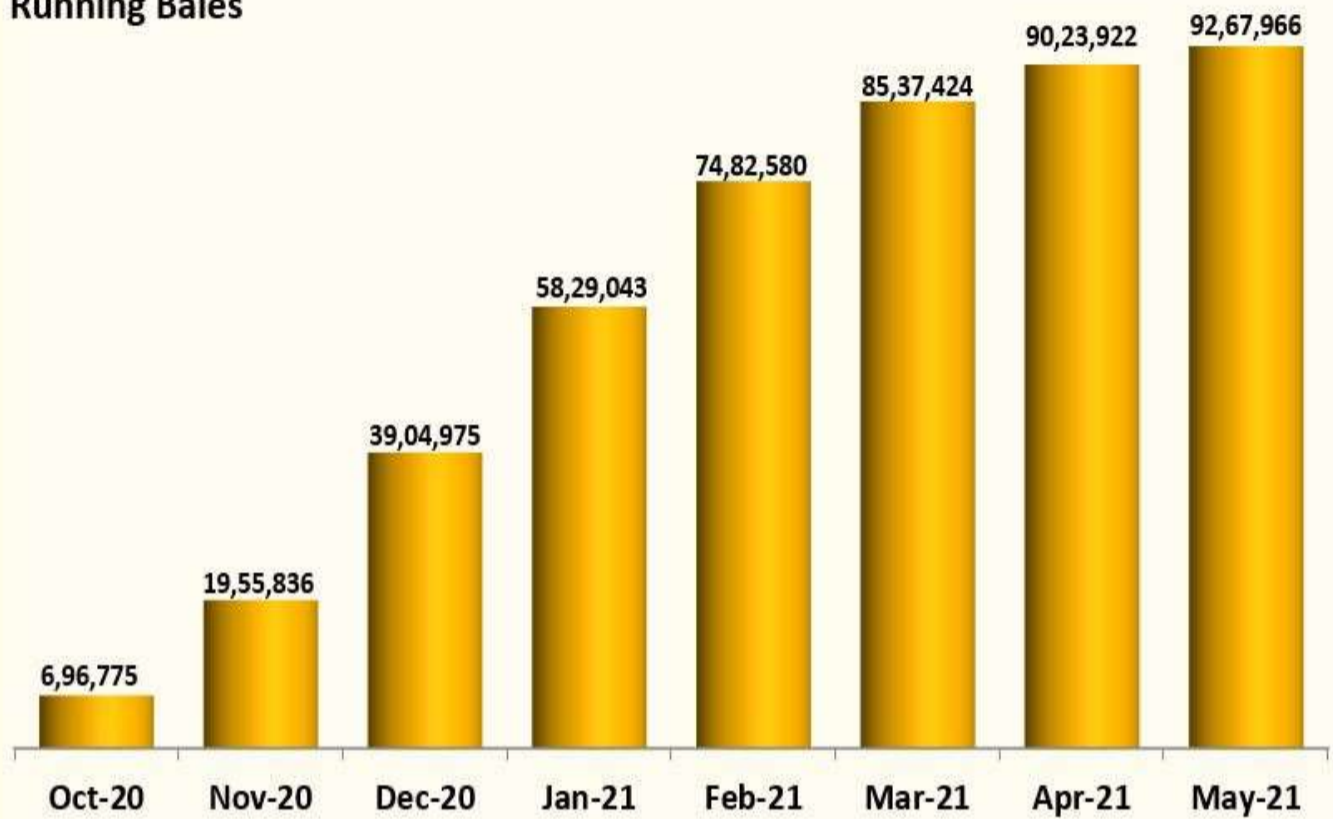

Gujarat Cumulative Cotton Pressing

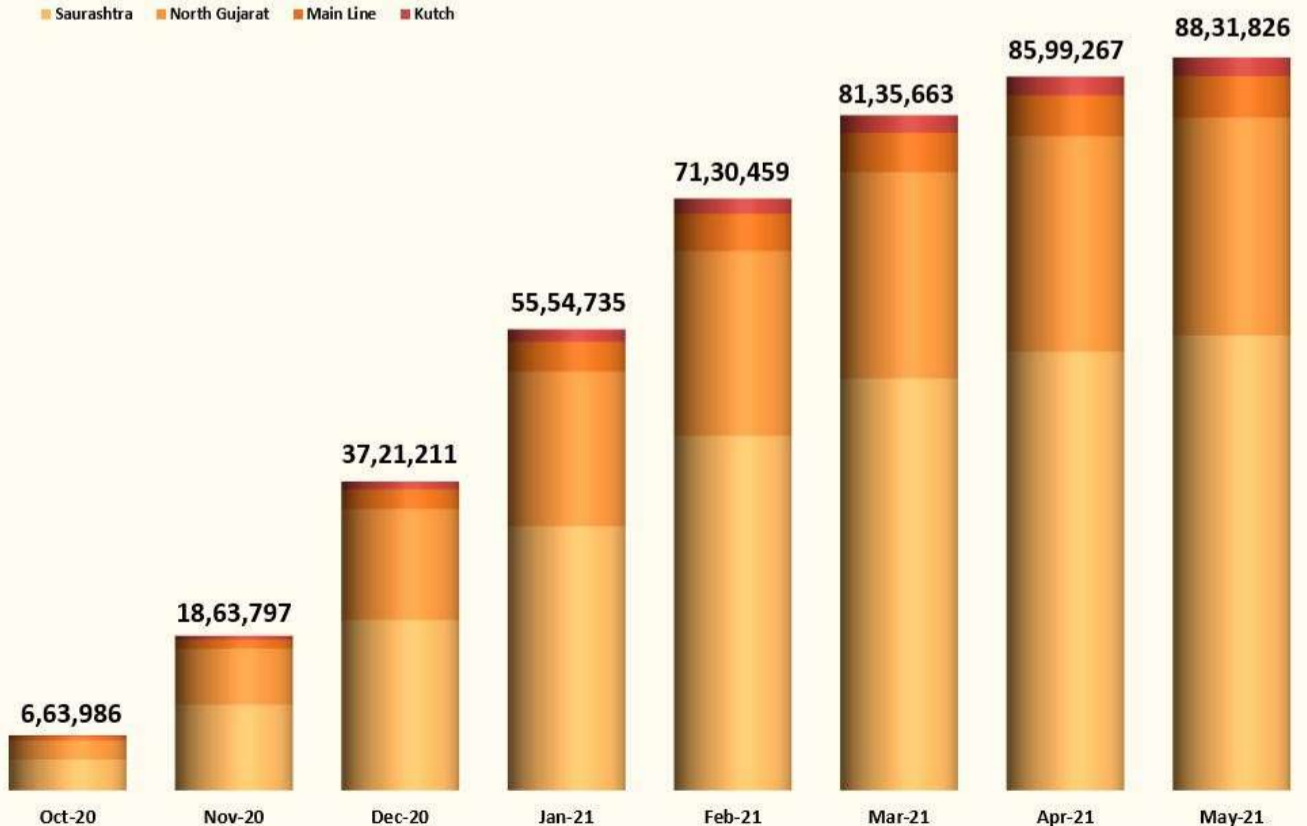

 ■ Kutch

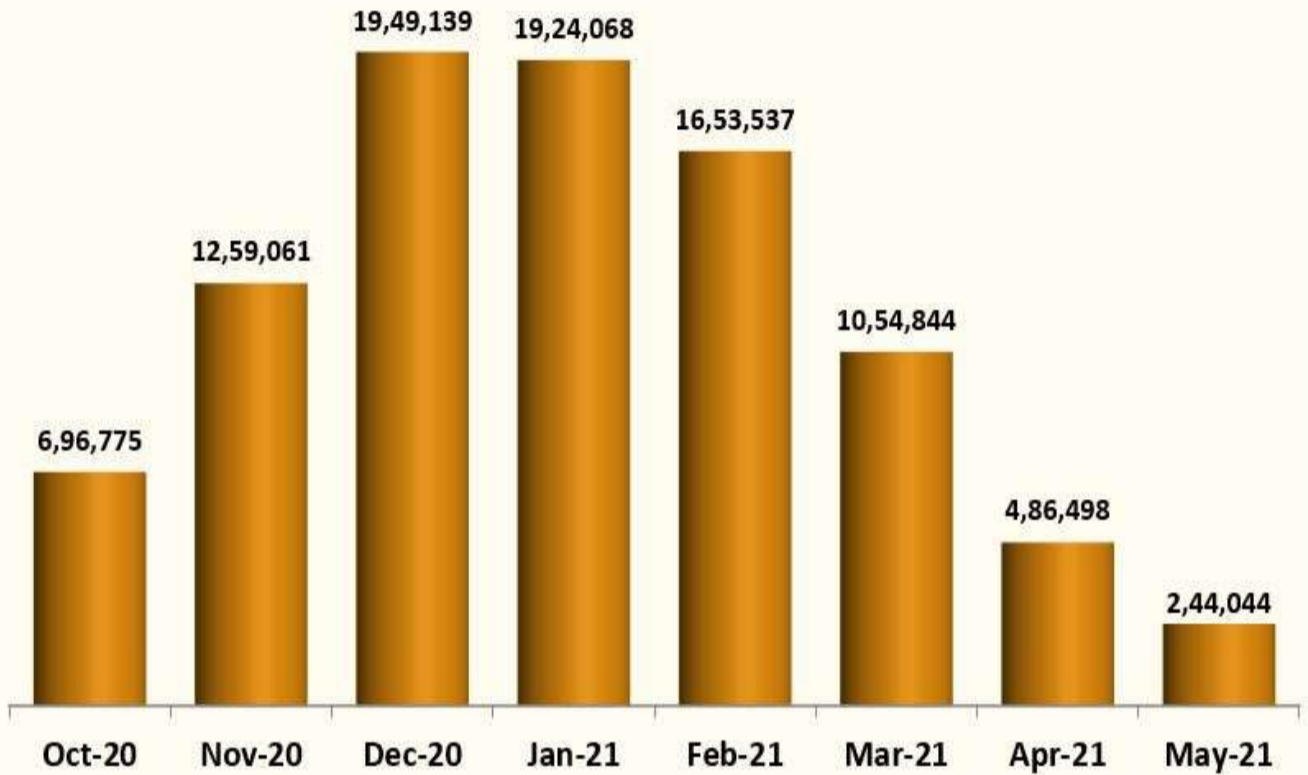




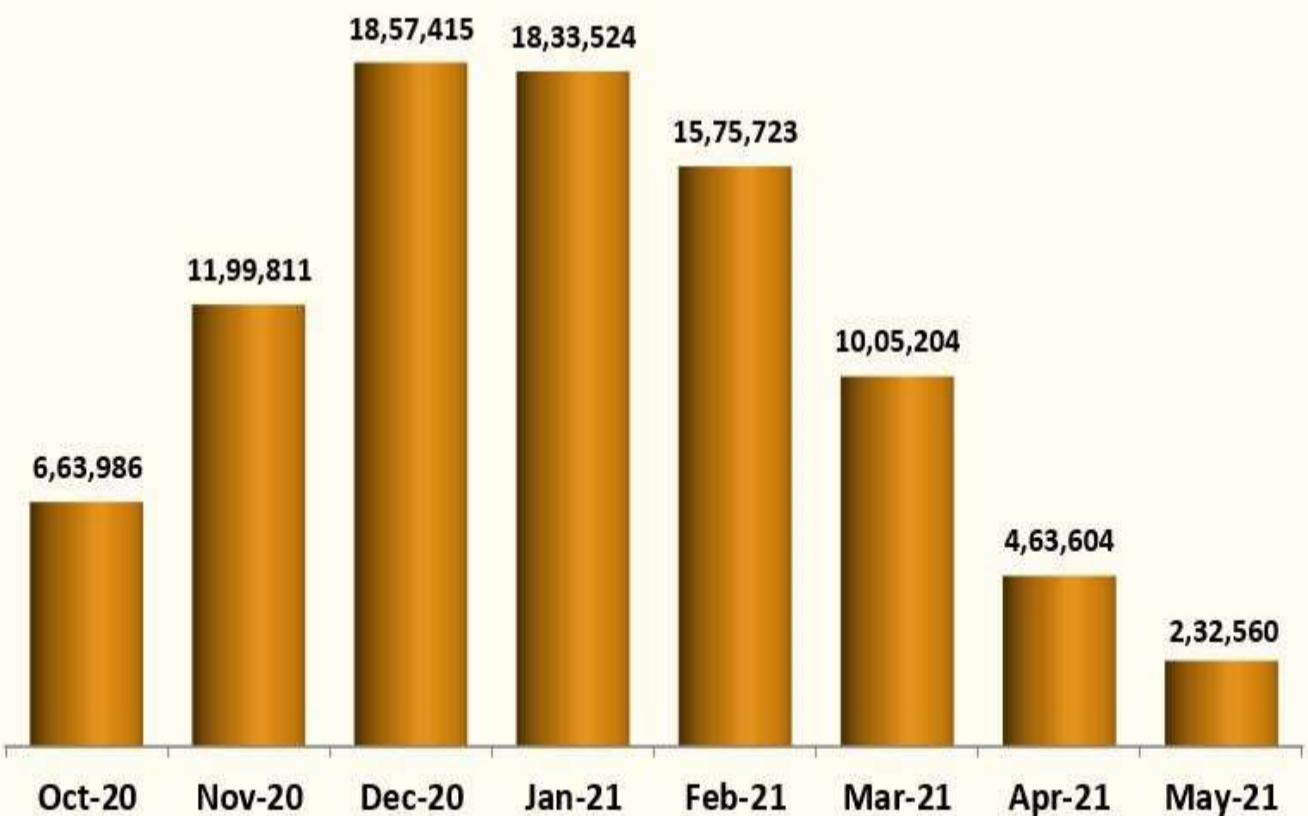

170 Kg Bales**

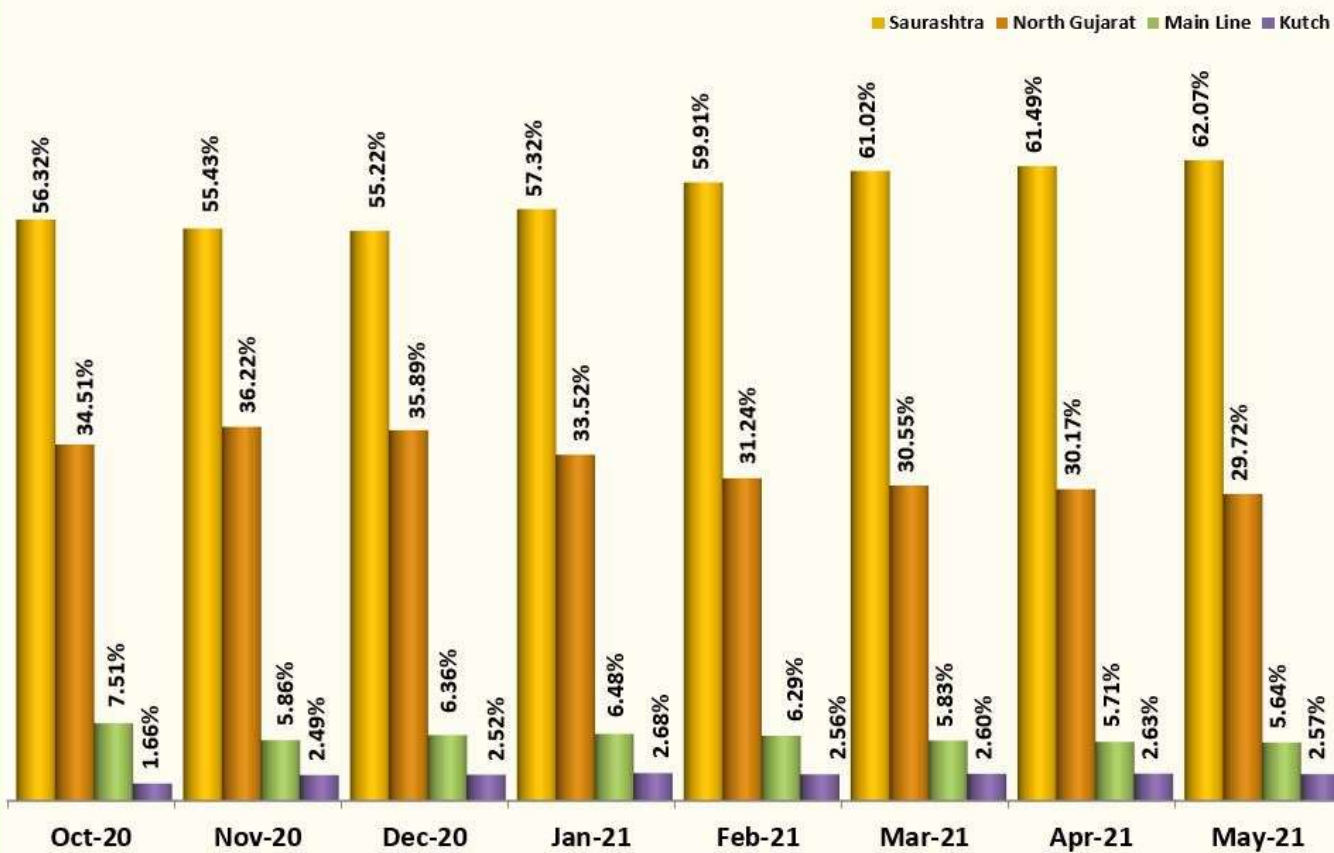




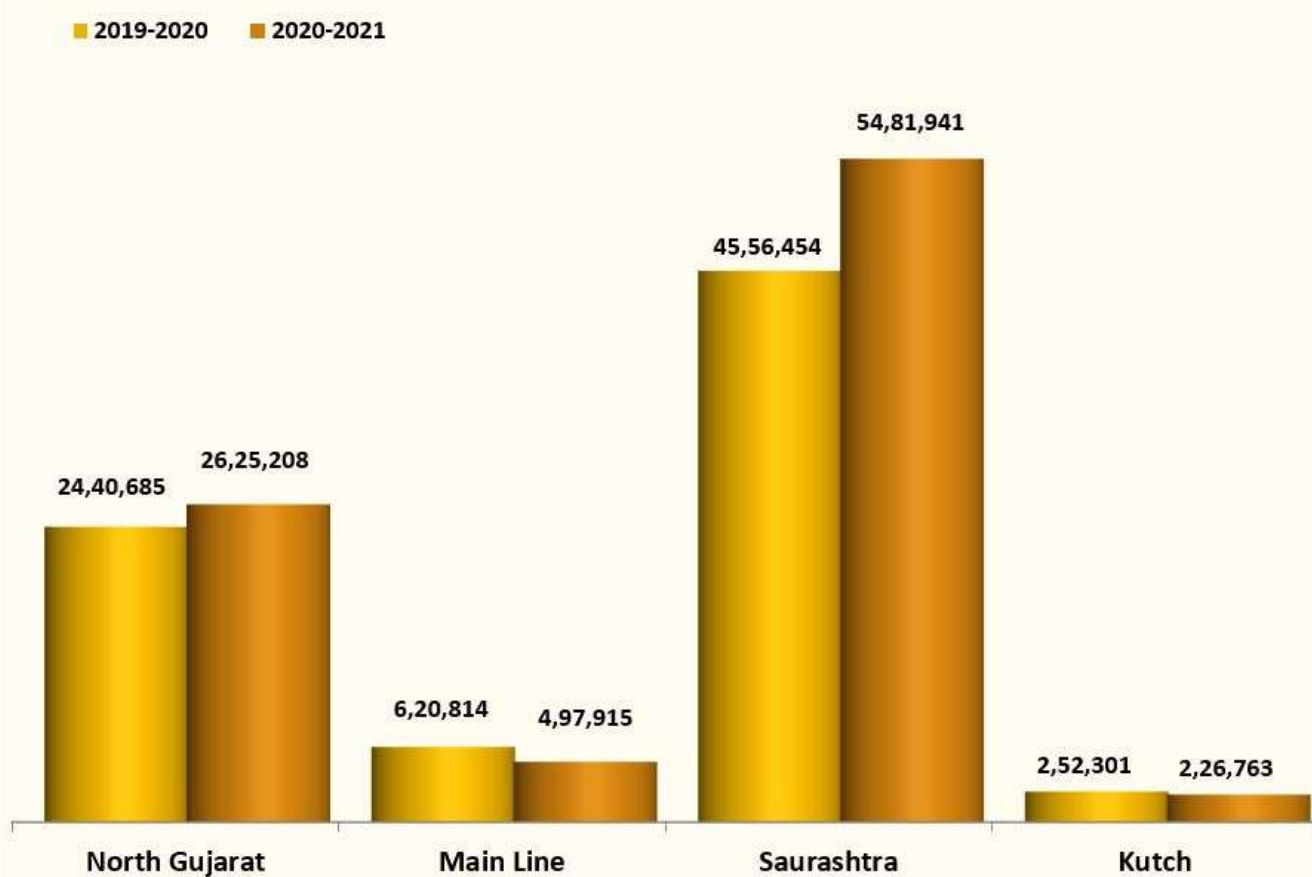
