#### **Summary**

- During the month of February Gujarat has pressed 12,65,854 Running Bales of Shankar 6 and 60,350 Running Bales of V-797 Total 13,26,204 RB. So the statistical bales of 170 Kg. was 12,06,284 Bales of Shankar 6 and 57,510 Bales of V-797 Total 12,63,794 Bales.
- Cumulative Pressing till 28<sup>th</sup>February is 64,46,478 Bales (Shankar-6 63,29,128 Bales and V-797 1,17,350 Bales), which is equivalent to total 61,43,114 Bales of 170 Kg. (Shankar 6 60,31,287 Bales and V-797 1,11,828 Bales).
- Average per day Pressing was 47,364 Running Bales and 45,136 Bales 170 Kg. for 28 days.
- During the month of February Total active ginning factories were 667 (Saurashtra 411, North Gujarat 204, Main Line 34 and Kutch 18).

During the month of February Gujarat received steady arrivals. So daily pressing average was nearly 47,000 running bales. Per factory average was nearly 71 bales a day which indicates that due to disparity ginning are running very slow.

Gujarat Kapas rate remained steady around Rs. 1,100 per 20 Kg at village. Variation in seed rate gave some time parity to ginner. Yet farmers are not willing to sale at lower rate and this slow arrival will be maintained for long time and season will run longer despite lower production.

Ginners are carrying old stock of higher rate so now selling current arrivals daily. Market remained range bound due to ample availability in the market. Gujarat Mills are covered up to 30 days to 60 days as per financial capacity.

March arrivals will also remain steady.
