Summary


- During the month of January Gujarat has pressed 18,44,598 Running Bales of Shankar 6 and there was no pressing of V-797. So, the statistical bales of 170 Kg. was 17,57,793 Bales (Shankar 6).
- Cumulative Pressing in running bales till 31st January is 53,76,285 Bales (Shankar-6 53,76,285 Bales, V-797 no pressing), which is equivalent to total 51,23,283 Bales of 170 Kgs. (Shankar 51,23,283 Bales, V-797 no pressing).
- Average per day Pressing was 59,503 Running Bales and 56,703 Bales 170 Kg. for 31 days.
- During the month of January Total active ginning factories were 635 (Saurashtra 398, North Gujarat 190, Main Line 34 and Kutch 13).
- CCI has procured 2,74,272 bales of cotton up to 29th January in Gujarat. Ahmedabad Branch 1,92,508 Rajkot Branch 81,764.
- During first Half of the month pressing was in full swing. After signing of Phase One of US-China trade deal, market went down on non-clarity in trade agreement about cotton purchase by China. And in the last week of the month negative news of spread of corona virus in China dragged the NY cotton futures to its season's low along with that sharply falling prices of cotton seed created huge disparity to ginners. So, during second half of the month cotton pressing remained very low.
- Later part of month ginning was slow. So the pressing of January is lower than December.


