#### MONTHLY PRESSING REPORT MAY-2019

### **Summary**

- During the month of May Gujarat has pressed 4,84,848 Running Bales of Shankar 6 and 433 Running Bales of V-797. So, the statistical bales of 170 Kg. was 4,62,032 Bales of Shankar 6 and 413 Bales of V-797.
- Cumulative Pressing in running bales till 31st May is 90,79,068 Bales (Shankar 6 88,58,732 Bales and V-797 2,20,336 Bales), which is equivalent to total 86,51,818 Bales of 170 Kgs. (Shankar 6 84,41,850 Bales and V-797 2,09,967 Bales).
- Average per day Pressing was 15,654 Running Bales and 14,918 Bales 170
  Kg. for 31 days.
- During the month of May Total active ginning factories were 263 (Saurashtra 206, North Gujarat 48, Main Line 2 and Kutch 7).

Most of the ginning factories are closing their operation due to lower arrivals.

Main line, North Gujarat and Kutch zones are not having big quantity of kapas. Saurashtra zone still has more kapas for the later part of the season.

Gujarat ginners are holding handsome quantity of cotton stock.


Now onwards more and more ginning will close their operation for the season as arrivals continue to declining and adverse market condition for the ginners.


